

All NEMO Committee Press Release: 25th September 2025

The All NEMO Committee hosted its third Annual Conference in Brussels on 24th September 2025

The All NEMO Committee third Annual Conference was held in Brussels, consolidating its position as the platform to address the challenges and prospects of the European internal electricity market and to share the views of stakeholders on market coupling.

The event brought together representatives from the European Commission, the European Parliament, regulators and other thought leaders from across the power industry, to share insights and engage in an open dialogue to help shape the future of SDAC and SIDC.

The Chairman of the All NEMO Committee, Rafael Gómez-Elvira González, underlined in his speech that 'despite this long-standing proven track record of the successful market coupling operations, the Commission is now proposing a radical recast of the Capacity Allocation and Congestion Management (CACM) Regulation, which raises serious concerns among NEMOs, both in terms of process and in terms of substance'. The Chair also reminded that EC, ACER, NRAs and all market participants can count on the All NEMO Committee to continuously bring improvements.

In the much-awaited policy session, the debate focused on how the CACM Regulation should evolve in order to keep the market resilient and fit-for-purpose. The issue of compliance with the overall EU regulatory framework was also addressed in the panel.

The intervention of **Mr. Nicolás González Casares**, Member of the European Parliament, also addressed that 'the electricity market reform provides stronger consumer protection, better decarbonisation incentives, and more affordable electricity. Its implementation must fully respect the spirit and objectives of the EMD reform. I also want to underline the crucial role of NEMOs: well-functioning short-term markets are key to integrating renewables and flexibility sources, and to enabling cost-effective system integration.'

There was also a dedicated slot on the <u>CACM Annual Report 2024</u>, where the NEMO experts introduced the SDAC and SIDC chapters, which included the intraday auctions (IDAs) for the first time.

The afternoon panel session focused on stakeholders' discussion on market coupling for a sustainable future.

Finally, in his closing remarks, **Mr. Lukasz Kolinski**, stated 'NEMOs contribution to market coupling is strongly appreciated by the Commission' and that 'NEMOs are and will remain an essential pillar in the Union's market coupling'.

The All NEMO Committee would like to thank the European Commission, the European Parliament, ACER, NRAs and all the speakers and moderators for the high-level of engagement, the diversity of perspectives and the quality of discussions that showed the importance of coming together to share knowledge and drive progress.
